VACANCY ON BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 157 ("WCID 157") anticipates a vacancy on its Board of Directors for a term of office expiring May of 2030. WCID 157 invites persons interested in being appointed to fill the vacancy to submit an application per the instructions below.

Eligibility

To be qualified to serve as a director, a person must be at least 18 years old, a resident citizen of the State of Texas, and either own land subject to taxation in WCID 157 or be a qualified voter within WCID 157.

Background

WCID 157 is a political subdivision of the State of Texas. It provides regional drainage and detention services to the land within its boundaries, and also operates non-potable irrigation facilities. WCID 157 acts by and through a Board of Directors comprised of 5 members, elected for staggered 4-year terms.

The Board of Directors hold regular monthly meetings at the offices of its attorneys, Schwartz, Page & Harding, L.L.P., 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Texas 77056. The Board also holds periodic Town Hall meetings within Bridgeland.

- Please confirm your availability to attend monthly board meetings (typically between 2 – 3 hours), monthly review of pre-meeting materials (approximately 45 – 90 minutes in duration), occasional committee assignments (as needed) and Town Hall meetings (1 – 1.5 hours estimated)

Application emails must be submitted by **5:00 p.m. local time on October 5, 2026.**

Selection procedures

It is expected that the Board of Directors will request applicants to attend the next meeting following the application deadline, which meeting is currently planned to be held at 12:30 p.m. on October 7, 2026. The Board of Directors expects to interview applications and select an applicant to fill the vacancy. Please bring valid photo identification to the meeting for completion of documents that must be notarized.
